The guide below offers indicative ranges to support transparency while retaining flexibility for tailored programmes and licensed tools.

Consultancy, Leadership & Advisory Support

- Strategic consultancy, facilitation and advisory support: **from £450 per day**
- Leadership away days, strategy sessions and workshops: **typically £450 – £600 per day**
- Written reports, reviews and strategic documentation: **quoted following scoping**
- Public speaking and conference contributions: **from £300**

Coaching & Mentoring

- Executive and leadership coaching: **typically £150 – £200 per session**
- Coaching packages (6 sessions): **typically £750 – £1,200**
- Mentoring support: **typically £100 – £150 per session**

Culture, Leadership & Diagnostic Tools

Jackshaw Consultancy is licensed to deliver **The BluePrint Toolset™**, supporting individual, leadership, team and organisational development through evidence-based diagnostics. Indicative pricing aligns with BluePrint™ benchmarks and varies depending on scope, scale and organisational complexity. Facilitation, coaching or training linked to diagnostics is quoted separately.

Governance Support

Governance support includes board and trust reviews, chair and trustee coaching, and board development sessions. Typical pricing includes:

- Governance reviews and diagnostics: **typically £750 – £1,200**
- Chair and trustee coaching or development sessions: **from £150 per session**
- Board development or strategy sessions: **typically £450 – £600 per day**

Fees are scoped according to organisational size, complexity and objectives.

Leadership & Transformation Programmes

We offer bespoke leadership and transformation programmes drawing on **The Pacific Institute®** mindset frameworks. Programmes may include licensed materials, facilitation, coaching and reflective practice and are priced following an initial scoping conversation.
